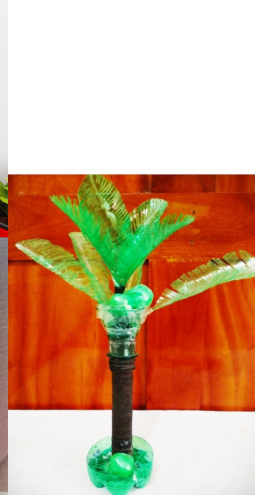

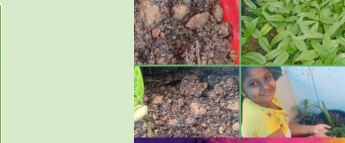

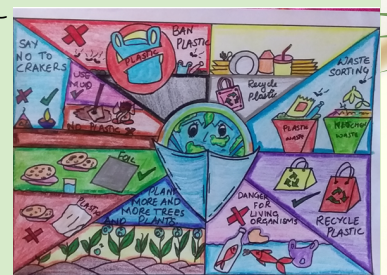

THE MAN WHO TAUGHT INDIA TO HUG TREES

SUNDERLAL BAHUGUNA WAS INDIA'S BEST-KNOWN ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVIST

Bahuguna, who died with Covid-19 on 21st May 2021 aged 94, was known the world over as the man who taught Indians to hug trees to protect the environment. He was one of the main leaders of the Chipko movement in northern India in the 1970s.

By switching off all the lights at our homes for an hour on Earth Day (April 22nd) we did our bit to conserve energy.
