

SUNDERLAL BAHUGUNA WAS INDIA'S BEST-KNOWN ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVIST Bahuguna, who died with Covid-19 on 21st May 2021 aged 94, was known the world over as the man who taught Indians to hug trees to protect the environment. He was one of the main leaders of the Chipko movement in northern India in the 1970s.
